A writing-intensive class integrated with course content in ANSC 4341 Food Microbiology and Safety

W Criteria:

Students will be allowed to choose a topic related to course content, in which they are interested and wish to learn more about. Students will be required to submit 15 pages of reviewed and revised material. While this course will be graded separately from the co-requisite course, failure to pass this course will result in failure of the co-requisite course as well. Instruction will be provided in a variety of ways, including formal instruction, individual conferences and written commentary. Revision of the initial outline of the review will be allowed based on comments from the instructor to improve organization, amount of material covered, etc. A draft of the review paper will be edited by the instructor and will be peer reviewed for content as well. Students will have an opportunity to respond to these reviews in writing and through the revision of the initial draft. The syllabus will contain the "F clause" stating that failure to pass the "W" component will result in failure to pass the co-requisite course.
