Soci 259W. Energy, Environment, and Society. Prerequisite: Engl 110 or 111 or 250.

W Criteria:

This course requires students to write four separate essays of four to five pages each. These are marked by the professor who returns them to the students to redo in light of the professor's comments. This writing accounts for half of the overall grade.

Students receive various forms of writing instruction for the course. They receive formal instruction before the essays on how to write; they receive written commentary on their writing.

Opportunities for revision are created by establishing a separate file for each student. The entire file is due every time that an essay is due, which allows the faculty member to monitor the students' progress over the semester.

Students can only pass the class if they pass the writing portion of the class, and they will be apprised of this in the course syllabus.
