Proposal to Change FYW as a Prerequisite

Given the recent adoption of a new First-Year Writing (FYW) sequence (ENGL 1007 and 1008) that will eventually replace the current FYW (ENGL 1010 or 1011 or 2011), the Committee on Undergraduate Writing Instruction (CUWI) proposes a new prerequisite sequence for all courses that currently require FYW.

Current FYW Prerequisite:

ENGL 1010 or 1011 or 2011

Proposed FYW Prerequisite:

ENGL 1007 and 1008; or ENGL 1010 or 1011 or 2011
